Comprehensive services include oncology-certified patient navigators, a state-of-the-art infusion suite, Penn Radiation Oncology on site, and access to cutting-edge therapies, innovative treatment options and clinical trials.

DOYLESTOWN HOSPITAL HOSPICE PROGRAM

Doylestown Hospital Hospice is a coordinated program of home care and support services for the terminally ill and their families. Focusing on quality care designed to provide sensitivity and support, patients are able to live at home or a home-like setting, such as a care facility, and enjoy life as fully as possible.

Although most insurance plans offer Hospice coverage, more and more families face rising costs associated with terminal care. Circle of Life funding provides hospice patients additional palliative care options that are not covered by Medicare.
